## **Summer Updates**

Many of you participated in the End of Year PTA survey last year, and we've been working hard over the summer to make sure your voices are heard. This year we'll be making a few changes based on the survey results:

• Online Directory (also available to print as a hardcopy): With a 50/50 split between people preferring online vs. hardcopy directories, we decided to try a FREE online directory program (AtoZ Connect) which has been used with success by many other schools in our area and which still gives us the ability to print for families that prefer using traditional hardcopy directories. Perhaps the best feature of AtoZ Connect is that its automation will allow us to release the directory much earlier than we have in the past – we anticipate this year's directory will be available by mid-October!



- More Variation in Event Days: A number of families mentioned that they are unable to attend Friday night events. To give all children at our school the chance to participate, the PTA will be mixing some Thursday night events into our schedule. We're also excited to try holding our first-ever weekend event this year, with the end of year Carnival being held on a Sunday afternoon (May 19, 2019). Mark your calendars!
- PTA Meeting Agendas and Minutes: At the suggestion of many survey responders, we'll announce PTA meeting agendas in advance of each meeting and will provide as much detail as possible to help prioritize your attendance. Remember, you do NOT have to be a PTA member to attend our PTA meetings anyone who is interested in the topics being discussed is welcome to attend. For parents who aren't able to attend but would like to know what's going on at RCV, PTA meeting minutes will be posted on the RCV PTA website within 48 hours after the meeting occurs.
- New Selection of After-School Activities: This year we're excited to offer an even wider variety of options
  for before & after-school enrichment activities, including new partnerships with companies such as the
  STEM Academy After School Club and Imagination Stage.
- New and Improved PTA Website: We've been busy spending the summer building a brand new PTA
  website, and we're excited to launch it at Back to School night! Among other things, our new website will
  offer users the ability to make online payments, view current volunteer opportunities, see our calendar of
  events, and hear the latest PTA announcements!

# **New Reading Initiative**

Did you know that with the loss of RCV's Focus School status, we now qualify for the **MCPS Reading Initiative**? This program provides an extra instructor in Grades 1 and 2 during the literacy block to provide students with more small group instruction and individualized attention as they learn to read. As a result, Grades 1 and 2 class sizes will actually be reduced to 14 kids (or less) per teacher during literacy periods!

While the MCPS Reading Initiative program only applies to Grades 1 and 2, it's worth noting that the accelerated math program that is already in place for Grades 4 and 5 has a similar effect of reducing student to teacher ratios for all math classes in Grades 4 and 5.

#### **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

#### Q: Will joining the PTA require me to attend meetings and volunteer lots of hours?

**A: No!** We are all busy parents and recognize that life includes many competing priorities. We encourage you to attend PTA meetings and volunteer at events, but neither of those is required. There are many ways to get involved with very short time commitments or flexible schedules, but you can also help just by becoming a PTA member.

#### Q: What should I expect at PTA meetings?

**A:** Meetings typically begin with our principal and assistant principal, Mr. Burns and Ms. Carr, communicating the latest news from RCV and MCPS. **Parents always find these updates extremely valuable!** Past updates have included up-to-theminute information on projected class sizes, teacher assignments, test scores, school funding, etc. PTA meetings give parents an opportunity to ask questions, communicate concerns, and raise suggestions directly with our school administrators. Agendas for upcoming PTA meetings will be posted online in advance of each meeting!

#### Q: Can I bring my kids to PTA meetings?

**A:** Absolutely!! During PTA meetings, we partner with BAR-T to offer free babysitting to children who are 3 years (potty trained) to 12 years old. Younger kids are welcome to attend meetings too, but would need to be monitored by you in the meeting area. Don't worry, we're all parents, so we all understand the struggles that come with trying to keep a toddler quiet!
